**Overview:** Person-centered care is defined as “care that is respectful of and responsive to individual patient preferences, needs, and values and ensuring that patient values guide all clinical decisions.”

This four-hour pre-conference workshop will describe the SDMSI program, designed to honor the individual’s preferences during current clinical decision-making. The SDMSI program ensures that patient values guide all clinical decisions. The presenters will focus on clinical decision-making in serious illness and will examine the value of a national framework for shared decision-making, demonstrate the use of certified decision aids, and illustrate the importance of the interdisciplinary team in achieving the goals of person-centered care. Participants will have the opportunity to apply shared decision-making skills in small group activities.

In 2018, the Florida Legislature passed a mandatory requirement for all DEA-licensed physicians in House Bill 21. All DEA-licensed physicians who are authorized to prescribe controlled substances MUST complete a 2-hour, approved continuing education course on prescribing controlled substances. This 2-hour course MUST be completed by **Jan. 31, 2019**, and at each subsequent renewal.
